<u>Class Content</u>: This course is a continuation of the Level IV class offered this past Fall. We will do a very brief review of hiragana, katakana, and add a moderate number of kanji. Additionally, we will continue to advance sentence and question grammatical patterns that lead to holding conversations. In the Genki text (see below), we will start our study on pg. 190, the Grammar section of Lesson 8. Of course, cultural aspects of the Japanese will also be included to facilitate learning the language.

<u>Class</u>: Class minimum is 3 for the class to make and maximum is 15 participants.

<u>Textbook</u>: <u>Genki I</u>, Third Edition, ISBN 978-4-7890-1730-5; available from Amazon, BN.com, etc. If you don't have this text yet, please be sure you purchase the *textbook*; other materials, such as the workbook, writing books, etc., are *not required* for class and are optional for your personal use.
